<p>What are the hazards Who might be harmed?</p>	<p>Controls Required</p>
<p>Spread of Covid-19 Coronavirus</p> <p>Client, practitioner & anyone else they come into contact with</p>	<p>Hand washing Hand washing facilities with soap & water in place. Stringent handwashing taking place. Practitioner to wash hands before treatment, between every set of moves & after. Client to wash hands before & after treatment. Clean towel for every client & practitioner. Gel & hand sanitiser supplied.</p>
	<p>Cleaning Frequently cleaning and disinfecting objects and surfaces that are touched regularly particularly in areas of high use such as door handles, light switches, therapy couch, chairs & tables using appropriate cleaning products & methods.</p>

	<p>Social Distancing Ensuring there is adequate time between clients to fully clean & that they are not both on the premises at the same time. Practitioner to do consultation over the phone for a new client or at a distance with a returning client.</p>
	<p>PPE</p>
	<p>Practitioner will wear mask, gloves, face shield and disposable apron. The client will be asked to wear a mask. Couch cover put over the top of the couch & face hole if used. To be changed & safely disposed of between clients. Practitioner clothing to be changed between clients.</p>
	<p>Other Clean therapy couch covering & towel to cover themselves for each client . Client to bring their own water. Questionnaire completed at the start to ascertain if having any Covid-19 symptoms & what to do if they show signs of symptoms within 7 days of a treatment. Checklist of what PPE was used & surfaces cleaned per client in case of track & trace inspection. Therapy room to be well ventilated.</p>
